## 235/2021 Clerks Report

- (a) Somerset Highways were contacted with copies of emails from 2006 agreeing to move the 60mph sign further along Galley Batch, as the work has not been carried out. No response has been received; this has been chased.
- **(b)** Two volunteers have very kindly stepped forward to help Cllr Sarah Emery with the flower bed by the war memorial. The Parish Council have also received a donation of 40 bedding plants from residents.
- (c) Announcement on 21<sup>st</sup> July by the Local Government Secretary Robert Jenrick MP that he had decided to implement, subject to Parliamentary approval, the proposal for a single unitary council for the whole of the existing administrative county of Somerset. A single unitary council for Somerset will be formed on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 to replace the county's five existing county and district councils.
- (d) The Fingerpost by the Oakhill Inn has now been repaired, let's hope when the wind blows the arms stay pointing in the right direction.
- **(e)** A report was received of a branch from a tree which had broken off and was now residing on the pavement. The other low hanging branches could cause injury or damage to traffic. The tree is privately owned so Mendip District Council were unable to offer any assistance.
- (f) Additional Street Lighting High Street, Ashwick FM84120. Payment has been received and the task work order is now with the Team Maintenance Contractor. The lead time for materials, permissions and completion is approximately 10 – 12 weeks.
- (g) A report has been received from residents and the difficulty of cars emerging from Fosse Road by the Oakhill Inn due to parked vehicles on the left of the junction. **Update** Cllr David Barlow will speak to County Councillor Mike Pullin and Cllr Roy Bailey will report the issue to the Road Haulage Association as commercial vehicles are also causing a problem.
- (h) Ashwick and Binegar Parish Council have put together a collaborative bid to facilitate walks around the Parishes of Binegar and Ashwick. These would be accompanied by illustrated and informative boards focussing on the historical features, the flora and fauna. The chief aim of the walks is to enable the health benefits, both mental and physical spending time in our countryside. Binegar Parish Council are putting the bid together.
