After a discussion the following proposals were put forward.

The Council **RESOLVED** in principle to cover the costs of £3,000 + VAT for a Highways report, this will be formally approved at the next meeting upon receipt of the quote.

The Council **RESOLVED** to appoint Mark Reynold from Context Planning to prepare an appeal statement supporting several reasons and submit to the Planning Inspector by 13th February at a cost of £3,000 - £3,300 + VAT. Cllr David Thorley will be the initial contact and feedback to the Parish Council.

The Council **RESOLVED** to increase the precept by additional £8,000 to cover the additional costs so the new precept to be applied for from Mendip District Council will be £23,000 which is an increase of 60.84%
