Somerset Association of Local Councils (SALC) has grant funding available to give to Somerset's town, parish and city councils. They are for projects let by community need, and for issues relating to reducing inequalities in health and wellbeing that are not already benefitting from funding.

There are smaller grants available up to £2,500 is applying through an application form. Details include usual contact details but also about the service, project, event or activity such as what will it achieve, how will it be achieved and who will benefit from it. The application form is 11 pages long.

Larger grants of up to £35,000 are available for projects that transform the council's capacity and expertise to collaborate with the community to tackle health inequalities. To apply for this an discussion needs to be booked with SALC's health and wellbeing officer.
