Land at 361998 147984 Roemead Road, Binegar. **Recommendation** The Parish Council recommended the decision is left to the Planning Officer. Comments given were that the scientific documents contained within the application were beyond the councils comprehension but there were comments about visibility, environmental effects, colour of the cladding and access to the property.
